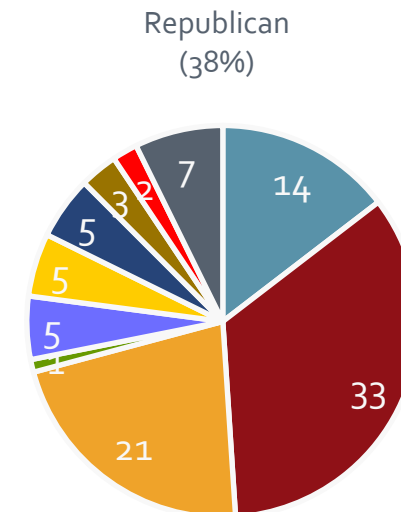
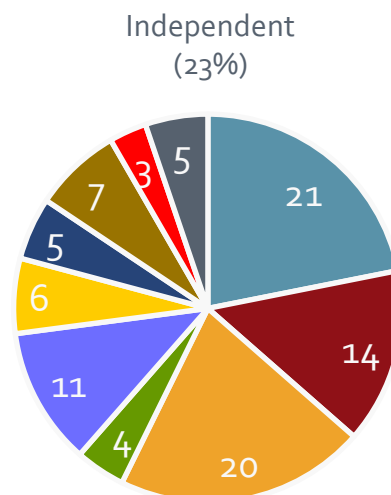
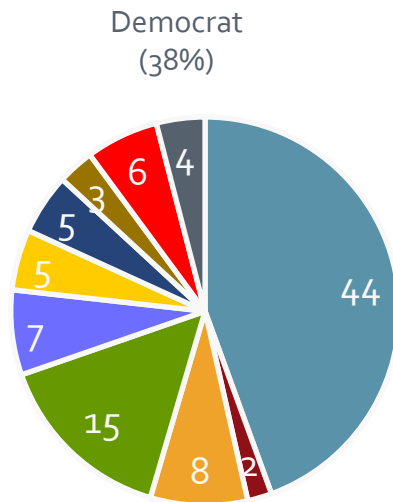
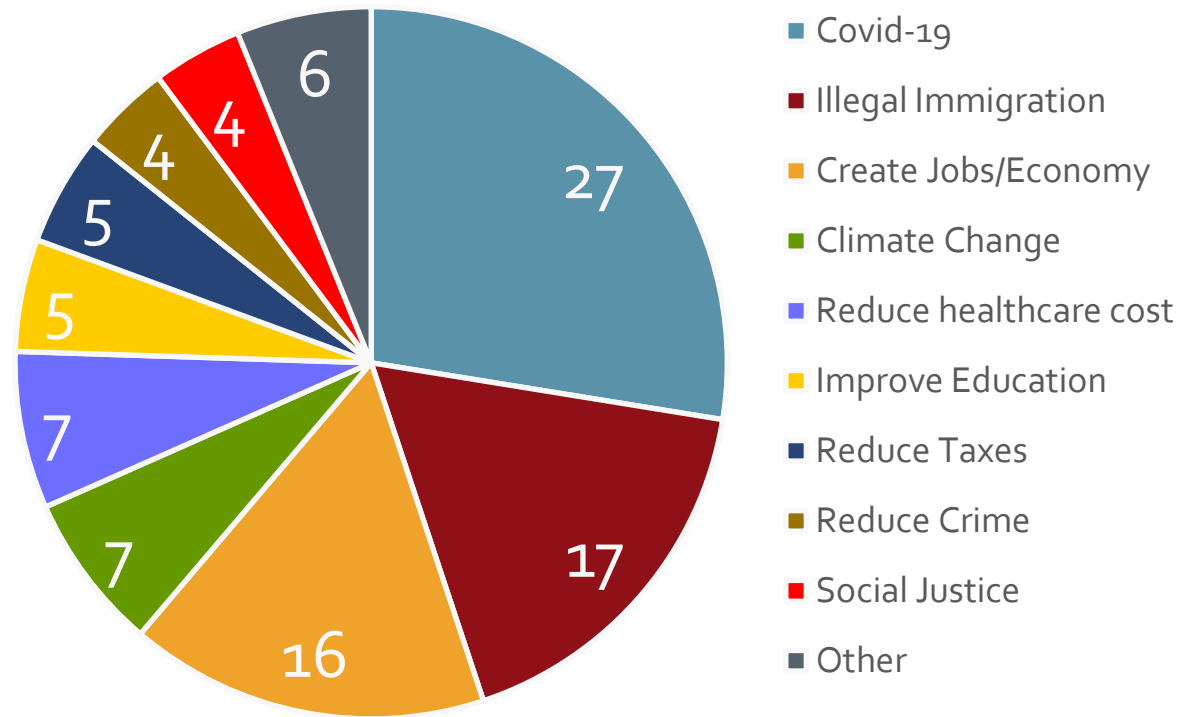
SURVEY METHODOLOGY

Telephone interviews were conducted September 28-30, 2021.

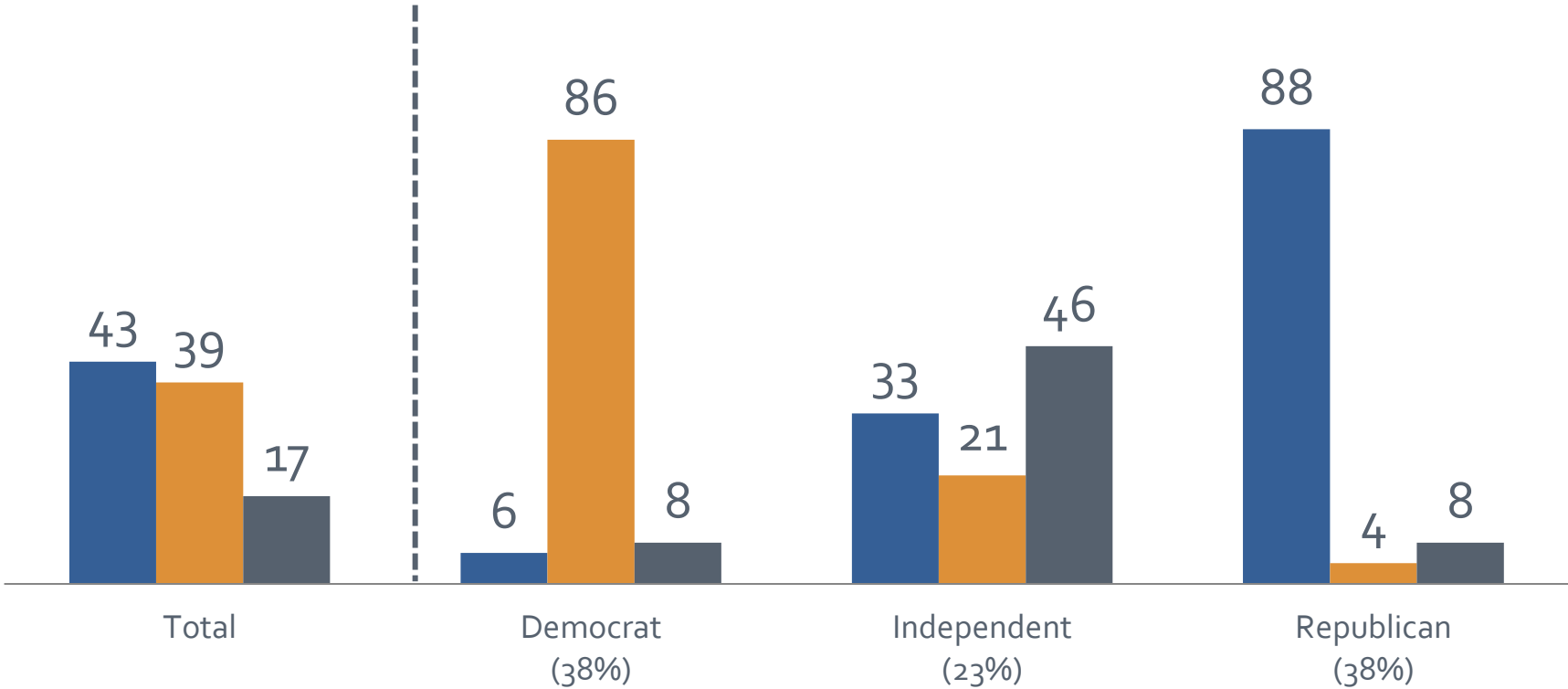
The margin of error is +/- 3.46%.

- Undecided

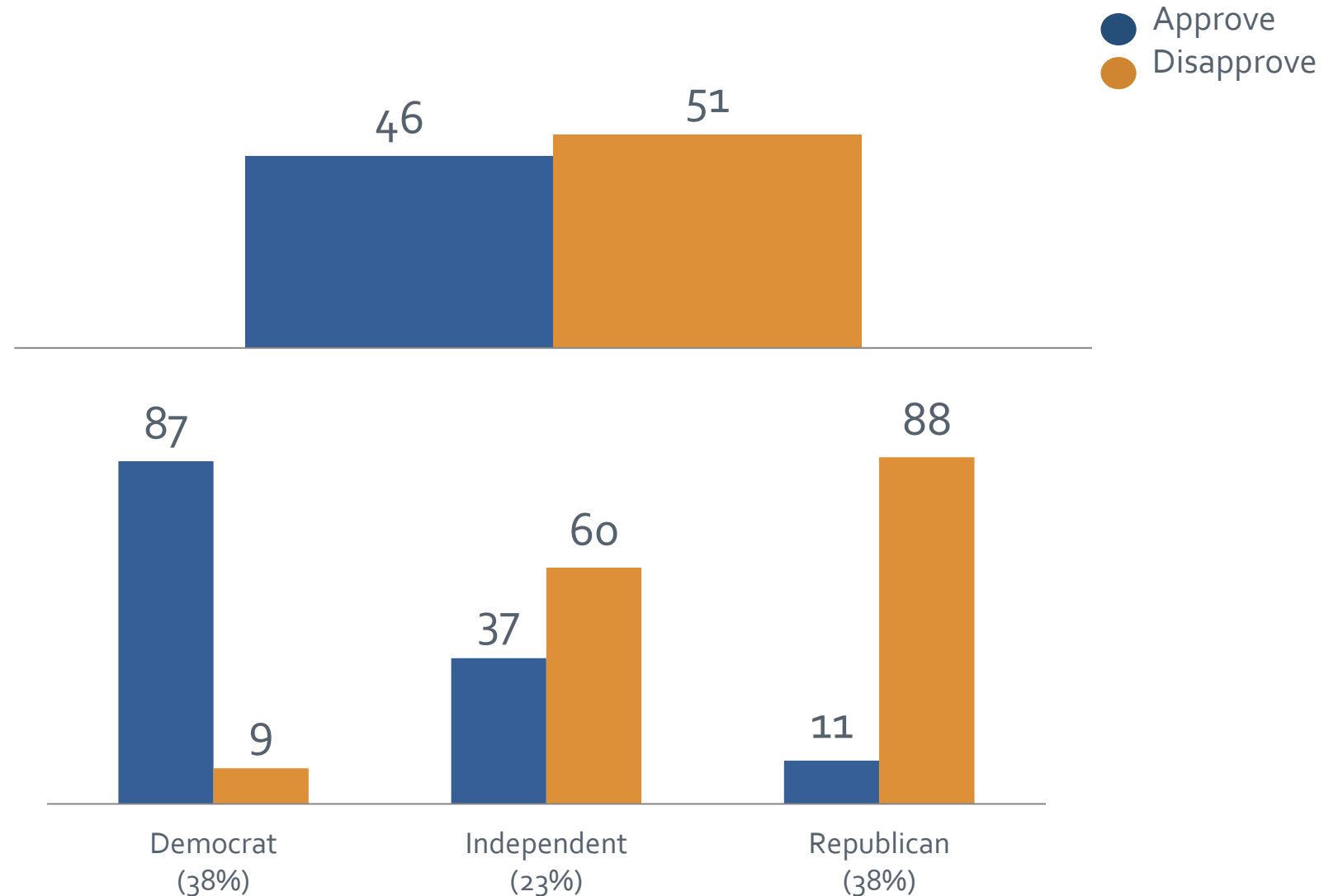

BIDEN APPROVAL

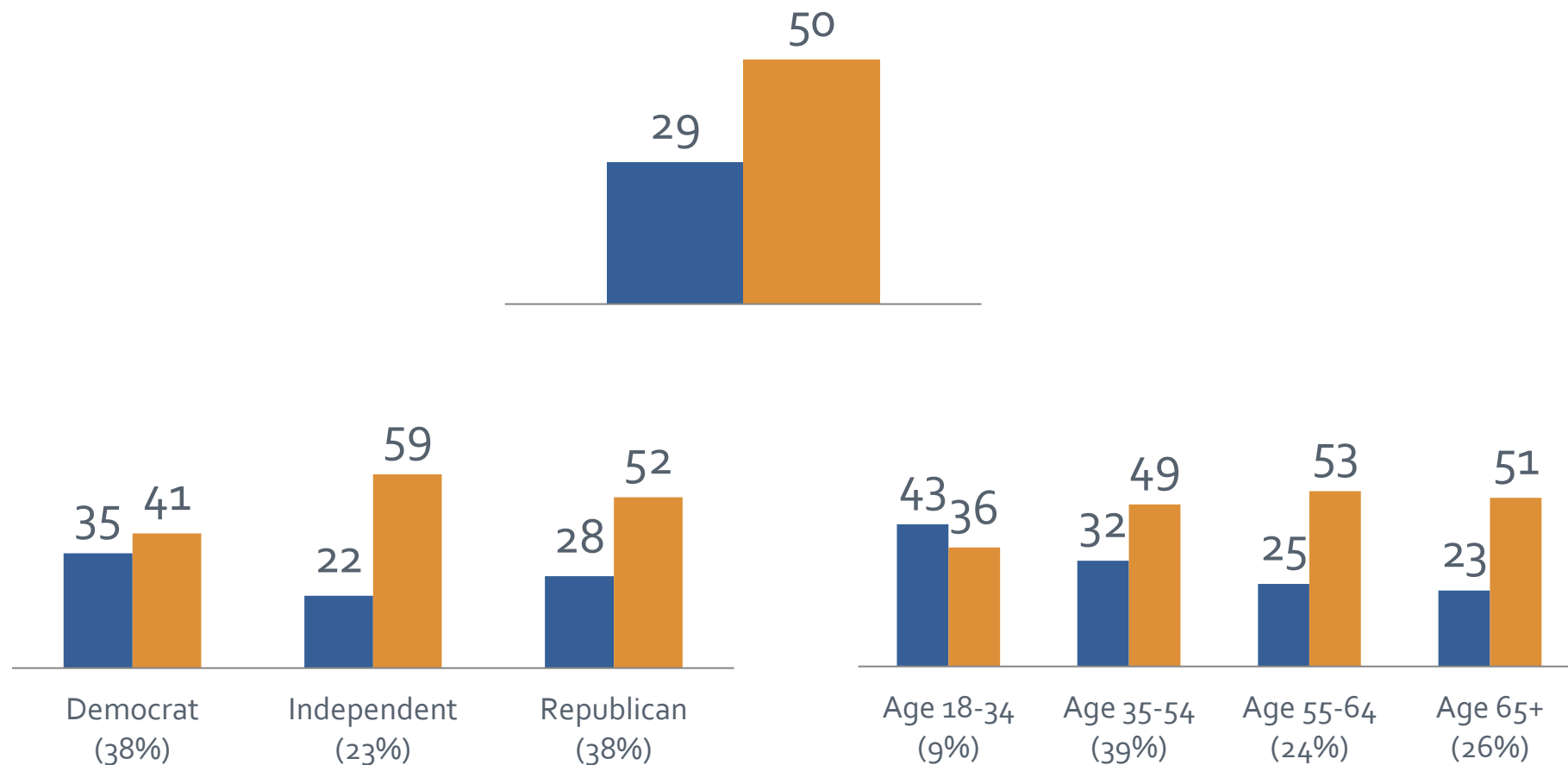
BIDEN: APPROVE/DISAPPROVE

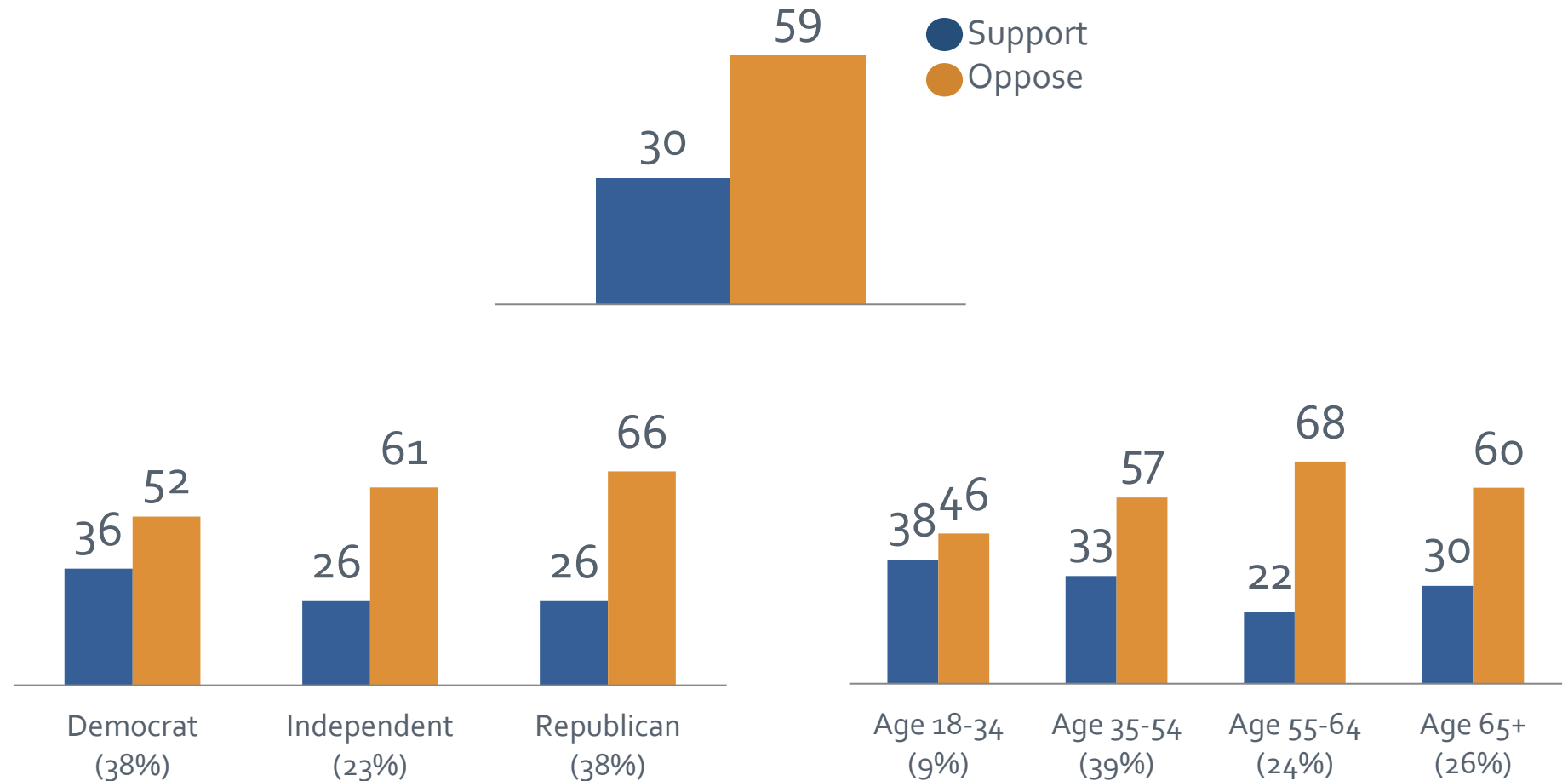

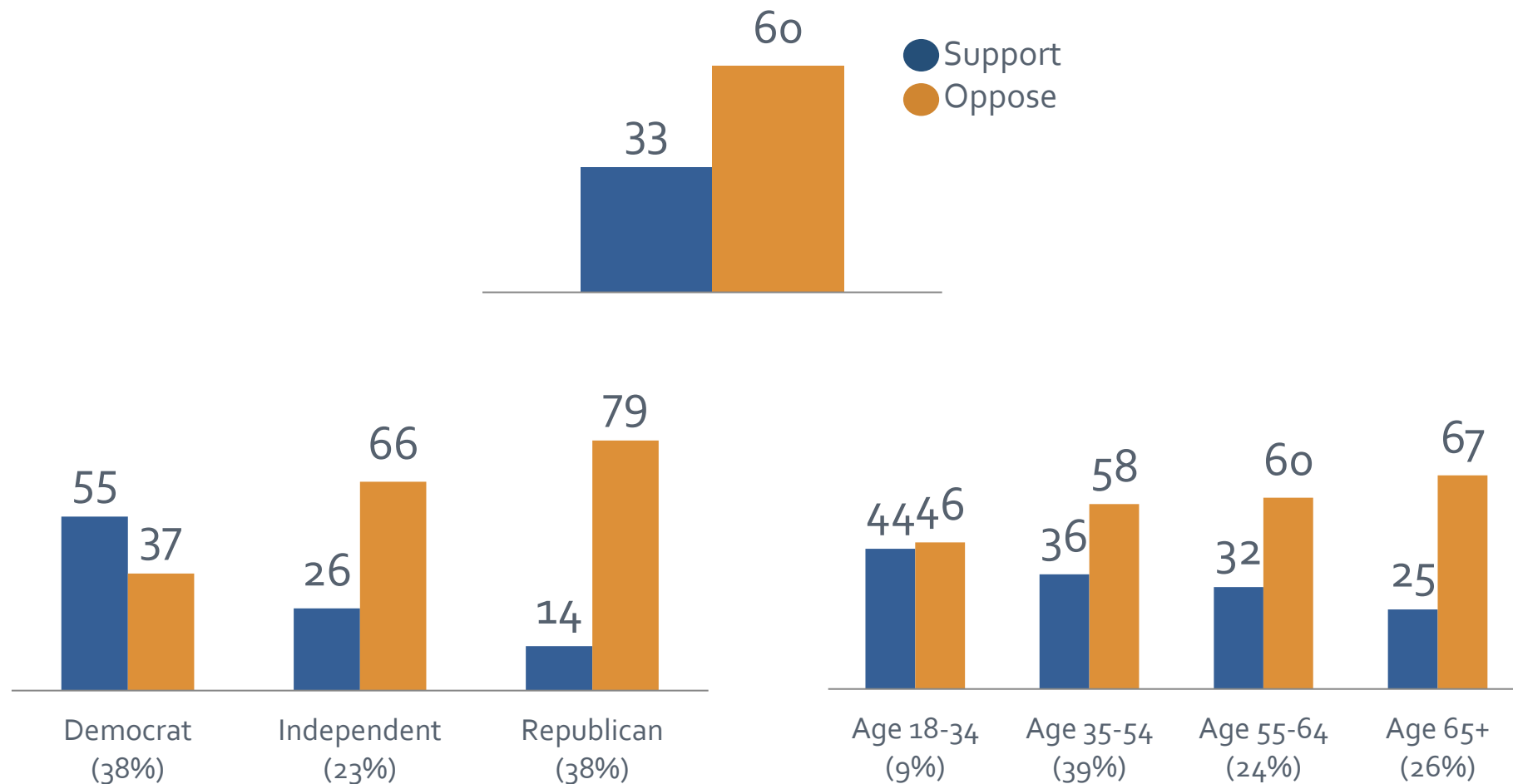
MEDICARE & VETERANS HEALTH ADMINISTRATION

But that means veterans have access to many fewer drugs, especially new medicines, than seniors do today. 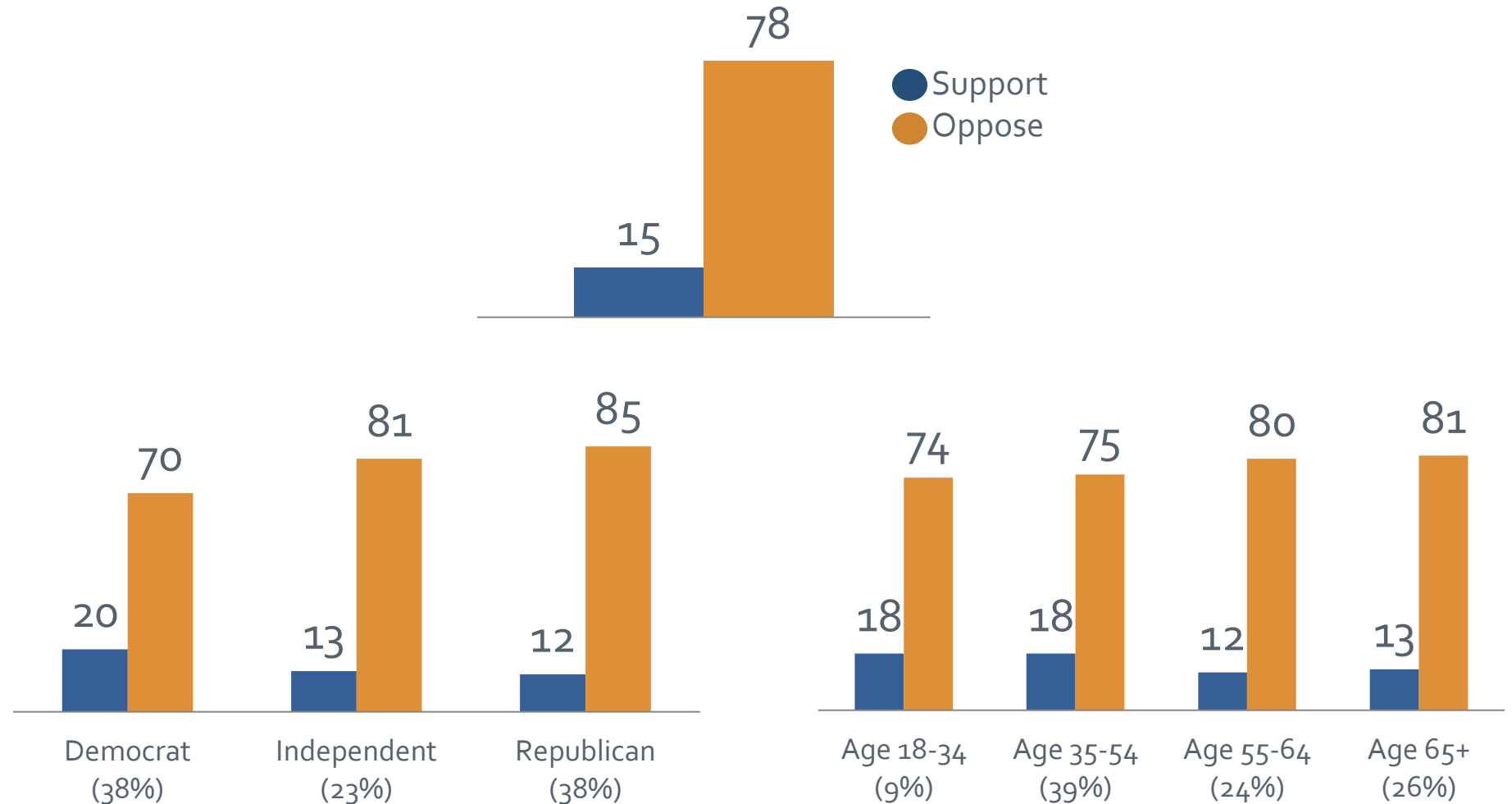
DRUG PRICING

One proposal in Congress is to base our drug pricing on systems used in Canada and European countries where government officials, not doctors, decide which drugs the government will pay for and which patients will qualify for them. 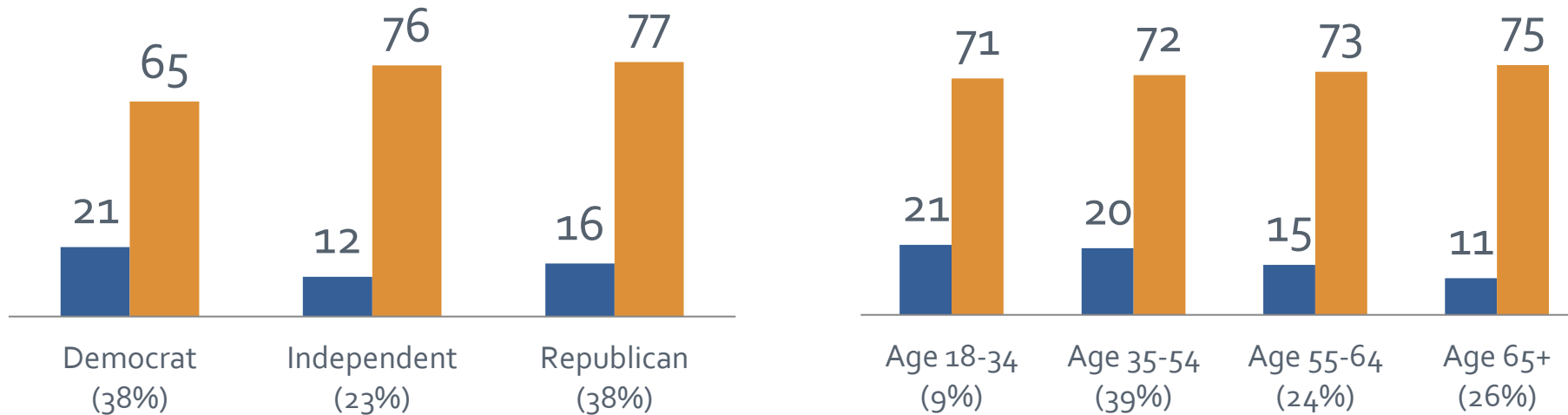
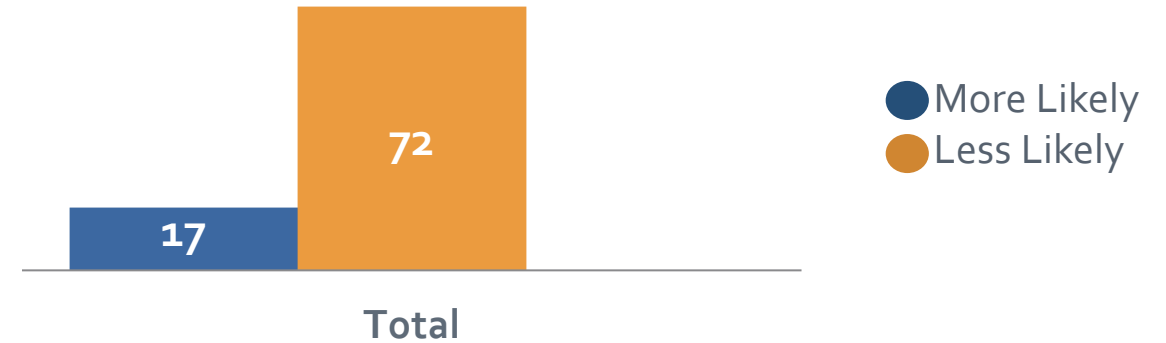
DRUG PRICING

Another proposal in Congress would have the U.S. government set prices for prescription drugs based on a mathematical calculation of the value of a patient's life. This mechanism is known as a QALY. 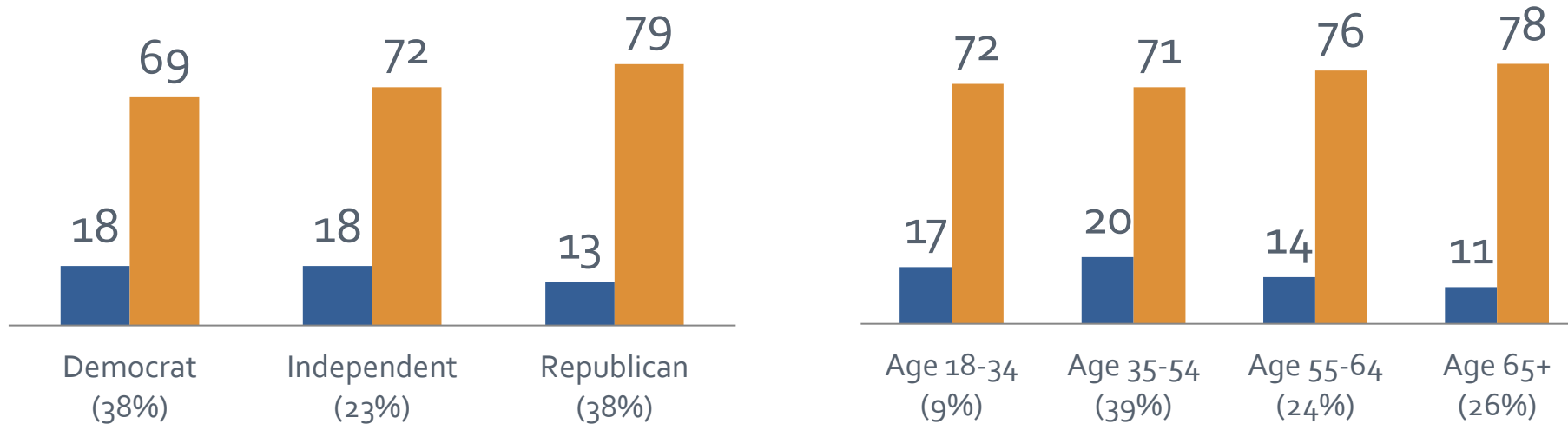
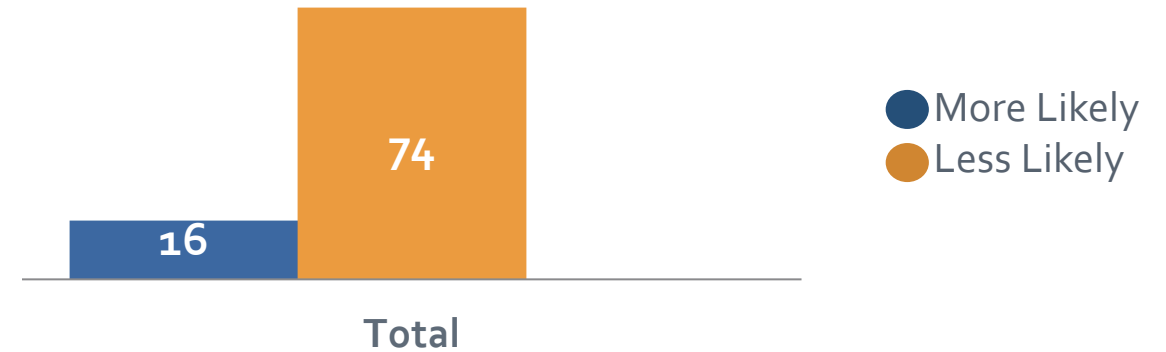
If you knew the following were concerns raised about these new government healthcare pricing plans, would it make you more or less likely to support these plans?

Under these plans, people who are older or who have disabilities are less likely to get the newest medicines. People have said this sounds like QUOTE "Politicians playing God." They worry people like the late Stephen Hawking would be unlikely to get treatments they need.



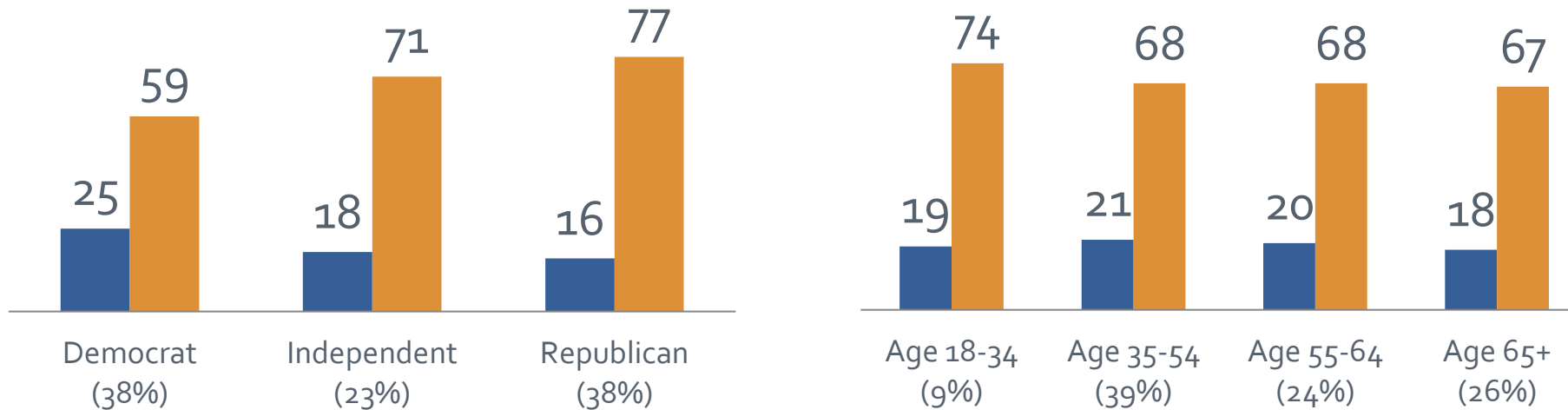
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These plans would mean seniors and people with disabilities would have access to fewer drugs than they currently get through Medicare.



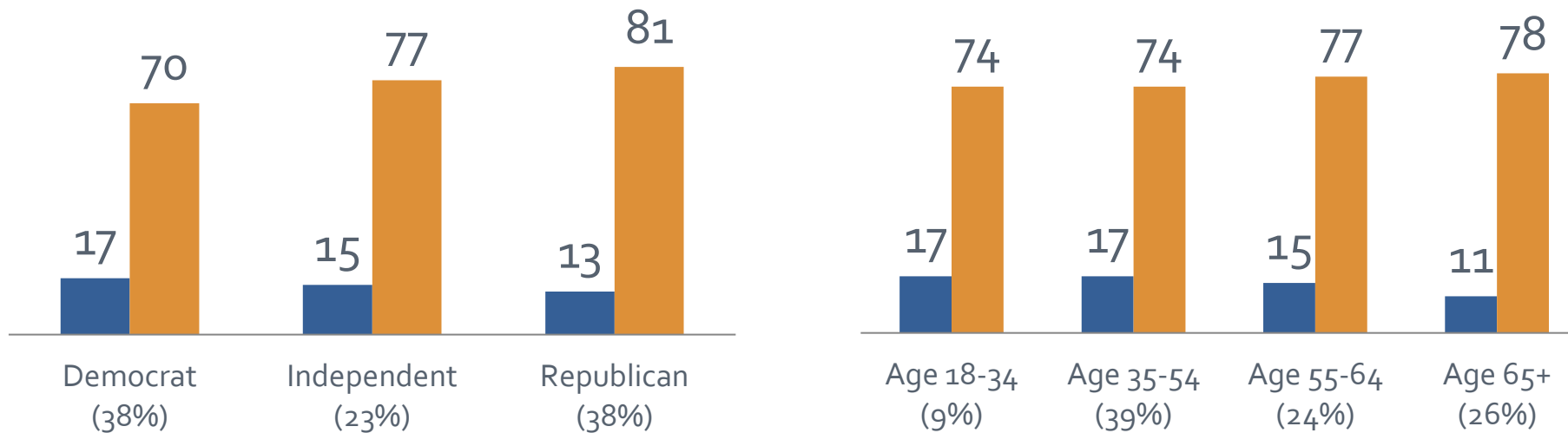
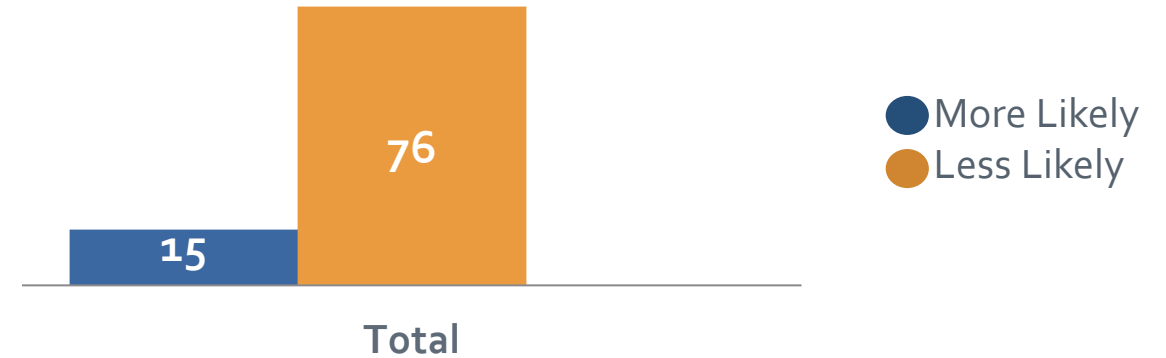
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These proposals would mean pharmaceutical companies would have fewer resources to invest in research, and that would mean development of fewer and delayed medicines for diseases like cancer, Alzheimer's, or childhood leukemia.



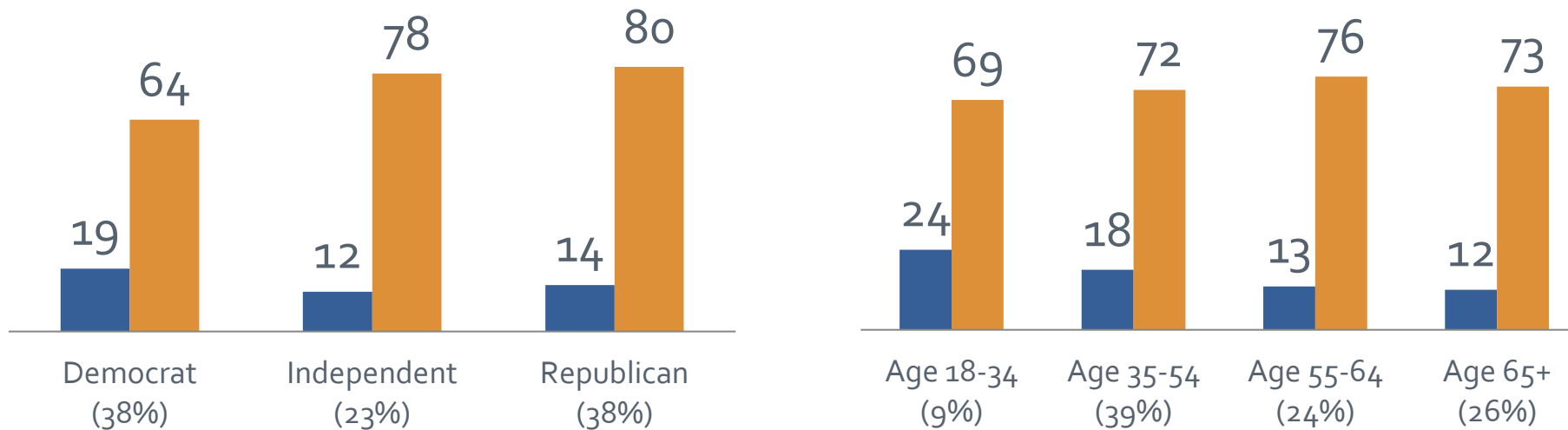
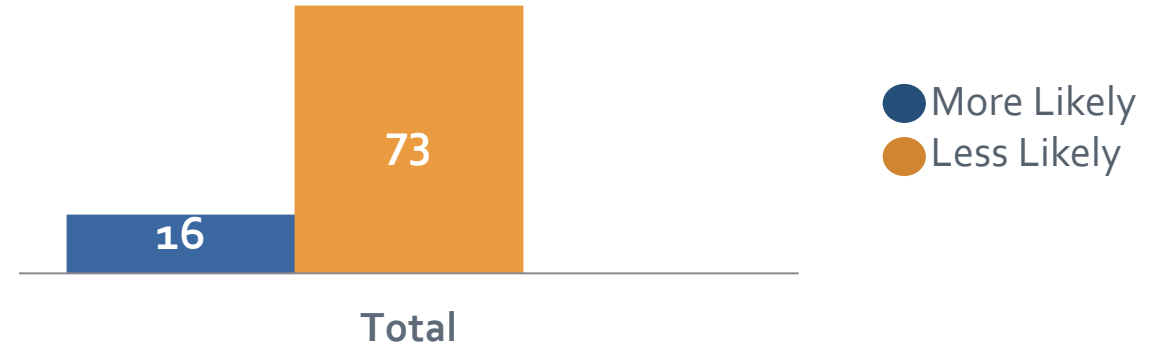
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These plans take away power from doctors to prescribe the medicines that best meet the needs of their patients, and instead put the government agents in charge of those decisions based on a calculation of the value of a patient's life.



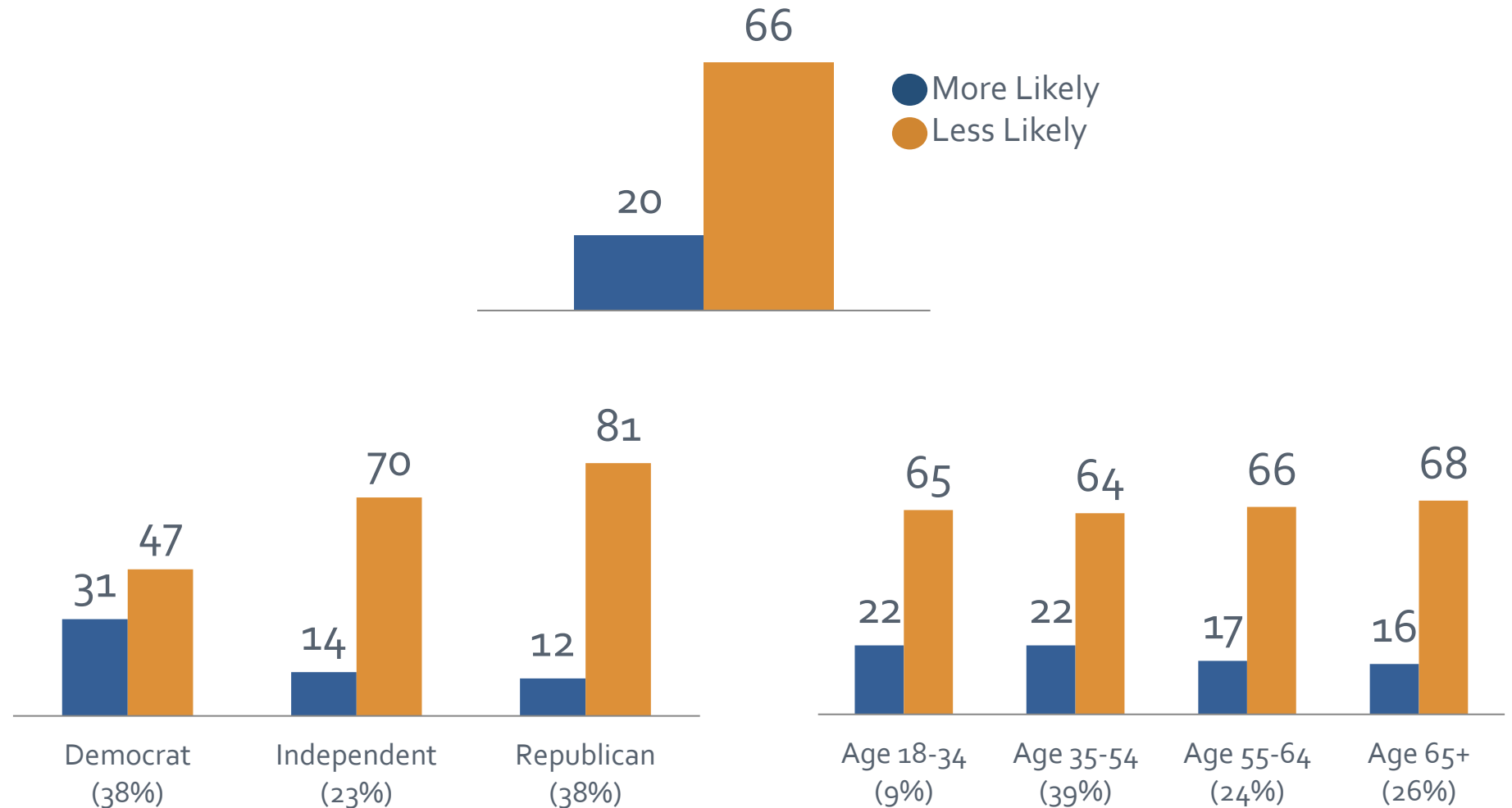
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The formula used to calculate the value of a life in the United Kingdom, one of the systems these proposals are based on, says one year of life is worth about \$38,000 dollars, and this is used as a basis to deny some expensive treatments and therapies.
